Born to the Ọteḷe Ọşífèsò Dynasty of Iyanro Quarters in Ìjèbú Ọde, Nigeria. A Descendant of Balógun Ọnáfowókàn ỌTÙBÚ, the first Balógun of Ìjèbúland.

In addition to his Architectural practice, Ọtúnba is a real estate developer, and a Rancher. His Ranch & Resort in Ibadan is used for movie sets, breeds cattle, rams, fish, chicken, and grows Cassava, Corn, and Teak.

Ọtúnba is a devoted classic car collector, polo patron, and horseman – with horsemanship running in his blood.
